Dining on the Road

At a shoot in 2016, I was visiting with T-Wayne Abshire about his restaurant and the cooking competitions he has competed in. T-Wayne is a World Champion Jambalaya Chef. He has also competed in barbeque competitions. T-Wayne mentioned to me how impressed he was with one of his barbeque competitors, a fellow named Naaman from Texarkana. Texarkana is only an hour from Shreveport, maybe a little less now that I-49 North is open. I made a mental note to check out Naaman's BBQ.

In early December of last year, Debbie and I were on a trip that took us through Arkansas. As we were driving North on I - 49, I did a Google search and found the address for Naaman's, set the GPS and headed there for lunch. We drove up and, as I had been told, found that the restaurant was actually in an old gas station. That is probably not all that unusual for a BBQ joint. I have been to some barbecue joints that did not spend much on the facilities. Some of the better ones focus more on their product and less on the ambiance. I took the character of this restaurant as a good omen.

Parked next to the building was Naaman's catering truck, which I am sure has been to many a cook-off.

We went inside to place our order. You do that in what used to be the front office of the gas station. After placing your order, you walk into what used to be the service bay area and now serves as the dining room. There were a lot of mismatched tables and chairs and a lot of eclectic barbeque

joint artwork on the walls.

We placed our orders at the checkout in the office. My selection was a sandwich called the “Red Headed Stepchild”. With a name like that, I could not resist. It is kind of an everything but the kitchen sink sandwich, composed of pulled pork, chopped brisket and sausage with coleslaw on a bun. It was really delicious, but I must confess, I ate it with a fork.

Debbie got a chopped brisket sandwich that was also delicious. In the photo on the left, you can see two different barbeque sauces were used. I believe one was hot and the other regular.

Naaman's has all of the traditional dishes you would expect to find in a Southern barbeque joint. They have smoked chicken, pork ribs, pulled pork and sausage and sides like baked beans, potato salad, and coleslaw. They also have twice baked potatoes and cheesy corn.

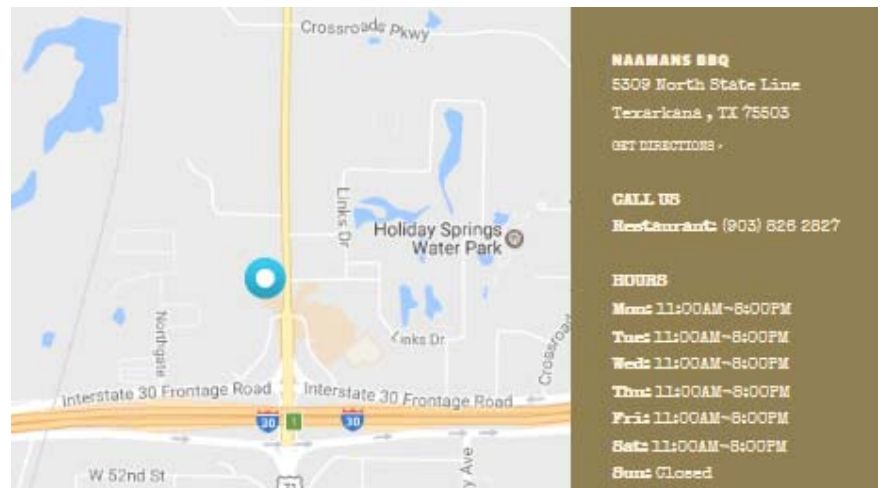
Naaman has gotten creative with the names of his sandwiches. There is Butt on a Bun aka (B.O.B.) which is pulled pork with coleslaw on a really good bun. Then there is Breast on a Bun aka (B.O.B.II) which is a chicken sandwich.

There is also the Dog-n-Heat which is a sausage sandwich with mustard sauce and coleslaw.

There are a couple of other brisket sandwich presentations, one called the Bishop and one the Blasphemer. If you still have room, there's THE Cheesecake or Cinna-BOMBS for dessert.

Life is an adventure and you can certainly have an adventure at Naaman's. If you are ever in Texarkana, check it out!

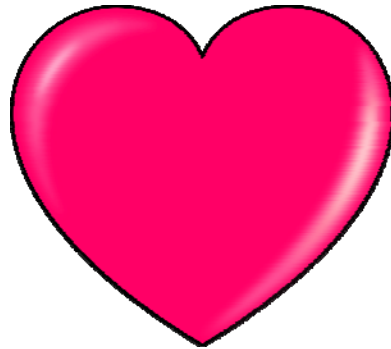

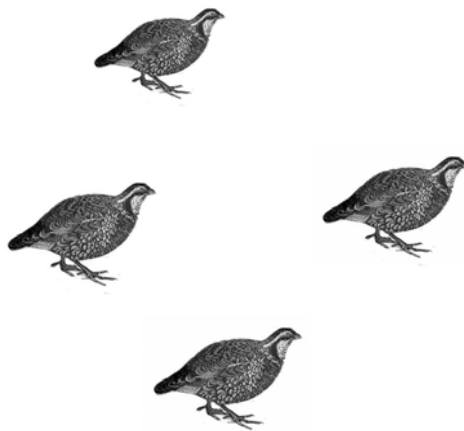

Be Prepared

When I was a youngster I grew up in a small rural town. We had a very active Boy Scout Troup and I was blessed by the experience of participating in Scouting. Those of you who have been Scouts probably learned a lot that has been useful to you later in life. One of the most important things I learned in the Boy Scouts of America is actually their motto, “Be Prepared”. If you remember that motto and live that motto, you will fare far better in life and endure much less stress. Less stress and more fun are certainly preferable than the alternative.

As we approach the beginning of Skeet Season, it is a good time to take steps to insure that we will “Be Prepared”.

That said, I thought maybe I should make a punch list of things that need to be done to make sure my Skeet experience in 2017 is fun.

1. **Planning** – Now is the time to review the Skeet schedule for my state and those around me to determine which shoots I want to participate in. I put them on my calendar in Outlook so I can avoid conflicts.
2. **Share** – Once I have my list, I need to share that with my bride so that she can put it on her calendar. She may be involved in some of my travel plans.
3. **Make Reservations** – Now is the time to make hotel reservations for those shoots you plan to travel to. I travel a bit for work and I try to stay in hotels that are part of a particular chain. I can use those loyalty points to help defray some of my Skeet travel expenses. I have already booked my hotel rooms for all of the Skeet shoots that I am planning to participate in.
4. **Pay Dues** – The gun clubs I belong to invoice their dues at the beginning of the year. This is the time to pay those dues. If you are not a Life Member in the NSSA or your state Skeet organization, pay those dues.
5. **Preregister** – Whenever possible, preregister for the shoots you plan to attend. The shoot managers will greatly appreciate your advance registration. They really like it when you preregister a full squad. This may give you the advantage of picking shoot rotations better suited to your needs. It will also help shoot managers to plan.

6. **Update your Average Card** – The NSSA just sent out new average cards. Make sure you check your card and faithfully post all of the targets you shoot. You would be surprised how many people show up to a shoot and don't have an up to date average card. I know people who use their cell phones to check their averages at the NSSA website instead of keeping up with their averages. That is a big mistake. Scores don't always get posted at the NSSA timely due to delays in reporting. Those averages may have you in a class different than what you are actually in. You could actually register for a shoot in a higher class in error. That will be treated as a "declared up" classing change and you may be stuck in a higher class the rest of the year.

I use an Excel spreadsheet created by Mike Skidmore to keep up with my scores and classes. It makes the math easier. You just update it after every shoot and print off a new copy for your next shoot. You can download that worksheet from the NSSA website or follow the link on the [Red Chute Gazette](#) Flyers Page.



7. **Check the math** – Periodically, visit the NSSA website to make sure your records agree with theirs. People make mistakes. Early on my shooting career when all I had was a 12 gauge, I shot in a 20 gauge tournament and registered 12 gauge targets. The shoot manager accidentally reported my targets as 20 gauge. I caught the error and reached out to the shoot manager to get him to correct the error. We all make mistakes, even shoot managers.



8. **Get ready** - Prior to shoot day, get your equipment ready. Make sure you have the right shells and anything else you are going to need. If you get this stuff ready and in the vehicle the night before you leave, you will be more relaxed on shoot day.



9. **Fill up** - The day before the shoot, fill up the tank. You don't want to waste time going to the gas station on shoot day. Even worse, you don't want to run out of gas.



10. **Map it out** - Know where you are going and how to get there. Whenever I go to a new club, I print a Google map with directions. I also use GPS. When I get to a new club, I reach over and tap the screen on my GPS and save the location for future use. If you have traveled for a shoot at a new club, make a dry run to the club the day before.

11. **Leave early** - On shoot day, leave early enough to get to the club well before your squadded shoot time. It takes time to get through registration, even though you preregistered. You don't want to hold up your squad mates and you don't need to be rushed. Get there early and have time to see how the targets and wind are going. You might need a potty break before you shoot. You sure don't need that distraction.



12. **Be organized** - When you get to registration be organized and ready to present the registrar with the following information which is required at all shoots:

- A. Name and address as shown on the NSSA score card.
- B. NSSA member number.
- C. State member number.
- D. Gauge classification as shown on your up-to-date scorecard.
- E. Concurrent classification as shown on your scorecard.
- F. You should have already determined the events and purses that you intend to shoot.
- G. Have your entry fee (money) ready when you register. Bring cash or check. Don't assume that the club can handle credit cards.



13. **Be considerate** - If for some reason your plans change, contact shoot management and tell them you are not going to be there. That way, they can squad someone else in you open spot. Not doing so is downright rude and inconsiderate of shoot management and your fellow shooters. Your mother taught you better than that! Being courteous is part of the "Scout Law".

When I was thinking about this article, I did not realize that my "Be Prepared" punch list would be quite so long. That is quite a list. If we can be prepared before we get to the shoot, we will have less stress and more fun. Most likely we will have better scores, because we will be able to focus on what we need to do when we step into the shooting station.

Don't forget to have fun!

Ron Duplessis had been leasing and operating the club which has a long history as a shooting destination for Skeet, Trap and Sporting Clays in the Baton Rouge area. Ron's lease on the property with the West Baton Rouge Sheriff's Department ran out. On Monday, December 26, the club offered free targets and food to all comers. As I was told, they also had a big sale, as they let the inventory go at some very good prices. The club had to remove all equipment and merchandise.

The West Baton Rouge Parish is putting the facilities out for bid and we should know by March who will be running the club. We are told that Ron Duplessis will be bidding, so there is a possibility that HRGC will reopen. We just don't know yet. We also don't know who else will be bidding or what plans they have regarding offering Skeet, Trap and Sporting Clays. We are hopeful that the club will reopen to service the needs for South Louisiana Shooting Sports community. We will keep you posted as we are made aware of new information. Hunter's Run Gun Club has three registered shoots on the calendar for 2017. At this time, it appears likely that those Shoots may not happen.

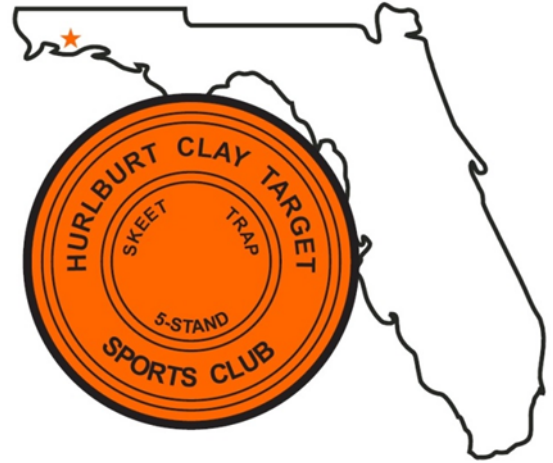

Help Wanted

We have immediate openings for the following positions:

♦ **Chef** – Chef needed to prepare plan and prepare food for special events with 5 to 150 participants. Must be able to work on a tight budget with less than optimal facilities and equipment.

♦ **Sous Chef** – Needed to assist the Chef in preparation and serving food at special events for 5 to 150 participants. Good dishwashing skills a plus.

♦ **Marketing Manager** – Needed to promote participation in special events (skeet shoots) and to solicit corporate sponsorship (prizes). Must be a skilled communicator with the ability to maximize results through social networking, Internet and other means with virtually no budget for expenses.

♦ **Skeet Czar (aka Skeet Chairman, Manager or MIC (Man in Charge))** – Needed to oversee the management functions of a registered skeet program. Those functions are Planning, Organizing, Staffing and Controlling. Qualified candidates may be male or female. In the event of the later, she would be the Czarina, Manager or FIC (Female in Charge).

♦ **Registrar**- Responsible for registering contestants and collecting the appropriate fees and dues. Candidate should be familiar with **NSSA** Classification systems and shoot management software (if lucky). Candidate needs to be able to do simple math (addition, subtraction and averaging).

♦ **Scheduler** – Responsible for squadding shooters. Qualified candidates must be a master at coordinating, placating, and diplomacy. A PhD in Psychology would be helpful.

♦ **Referee** – Must be knowledgeable of the rules of the game of American Skeet, a fast thinker and have the ability to take command of the skeet field to which he or she is assigned. Candidates should have good eyesight and be physically able to stand in the hot sun for hours. Experience dealing with difficult people a plus.

♦ **Scorekeeper** – The scorekeeper manages the scoreboard, evaluating the results, determining the winners in accordance to **NSSA** rules and posting those results for all to see.

♦ **Mentor/Coach/Recruiter** – Encourages, teaches and recruits new shooters to the sport.

♦ **Helper** – The person selected for this position must be able to help or fill in for any of the individuals listed above on a moments noticed. There are many opening for this position.

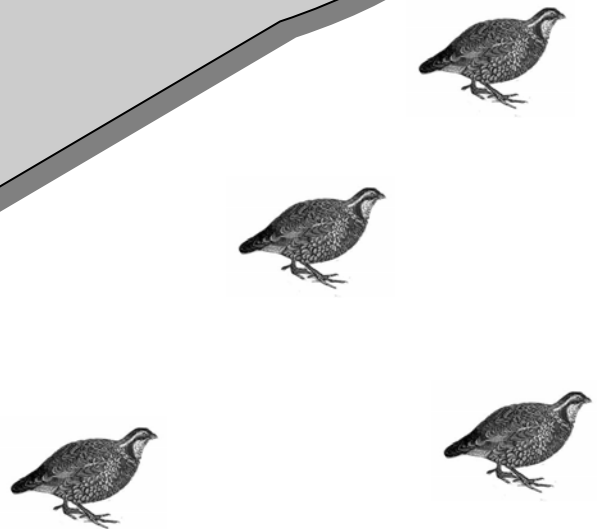
